

## 2018 Coleman Memorial Park Baseball Hitting Contest

The 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Coleman Memorial Park Baseball Hitting Contest was held on Sunday, 12 August, because of wet grounds on Saturday. It was only the third time in its history that it was held on its rain date.

Matthew Seibert of Lititz won the Teener Division with a score of 50 points. Alex Lingle, last year's Youth Division winner, finished second, 11 points off the pace. Alex plays for the Cleona Teener team.

Christian Anspach, from Jonestown, won the Youth Division with a score of 24 points. Caeden Sechrist of Lebanon finished second with a score of 20 points. Ben DiScullo of Lebanon also tied for second with a score of twenty points.

Jamye Bonanno of Lewisberry won her 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive and 12<sup>th</sup> overall Women's Division with a score of 58 points. Beth Mease, Elizabethtown, finished a distant second with 20 points

Tom Morgan Sr. of Myerstown won his second consecutive and third overall Senior Division title with a combined score of his age and batting points achieved with 122 points.
