

2019 Coleman Memorial Park Baseball Hitting Contest

The 33rd Annual Coleman Memorial Park Baseball Hitting contest was held on Saturday, 17 August 2019.

In the Adult Division, Dylan Sechrist of Lebanon won his first career championship with 8 homeruns and 100 points beating out last year's Adult champion Justin Mease of Elizabethtown who had 7 homeruns and 94 points. Grant Fisher of Palmyra, finished in third place with 6 homeruns and 77 points. Cody Phillips finished in fourth place with 6 homeruns and 74 points.

The Legion Division was won by Thomas Zeigler of Palmyra with 3 homeruns and 75 points. Colby Neal of Lebanon was in second place with 1 homerun and 33 points. Wyatt Menzel from Myerstown finished in third place with 34 points.

Alex Lingle of the Cleona Teener team won the Teener Division with a score of 35 points. This was his fifth career championship as he moves up through the age divisions.

Colton Shaffer from Lebanon won the Youth Division with 33 points. Second place went to Chase Norris, also from Lebanon with a score of 29 points. Altoona's Grant Okonak finished third with a score of 28 points, while Caeden Sechrist of Lebanon held down fourth place with a score of 27 points.

Jamye Bonanno of Lewisberry won her 6th consecutive and 13th overall Women's Division title with a score of 50 points. Beth Mease of Elizabethtown finished a distant second with 19 points.

Mike Miller of Annville reclaimed the Senior Division title having last won in 2016 with a combined score of his age and batting points achieved with 119 points. It was Miller's 15th career Senior Division Title. Tom Morgan Sr. of Myerstown finished second with 116 points.
